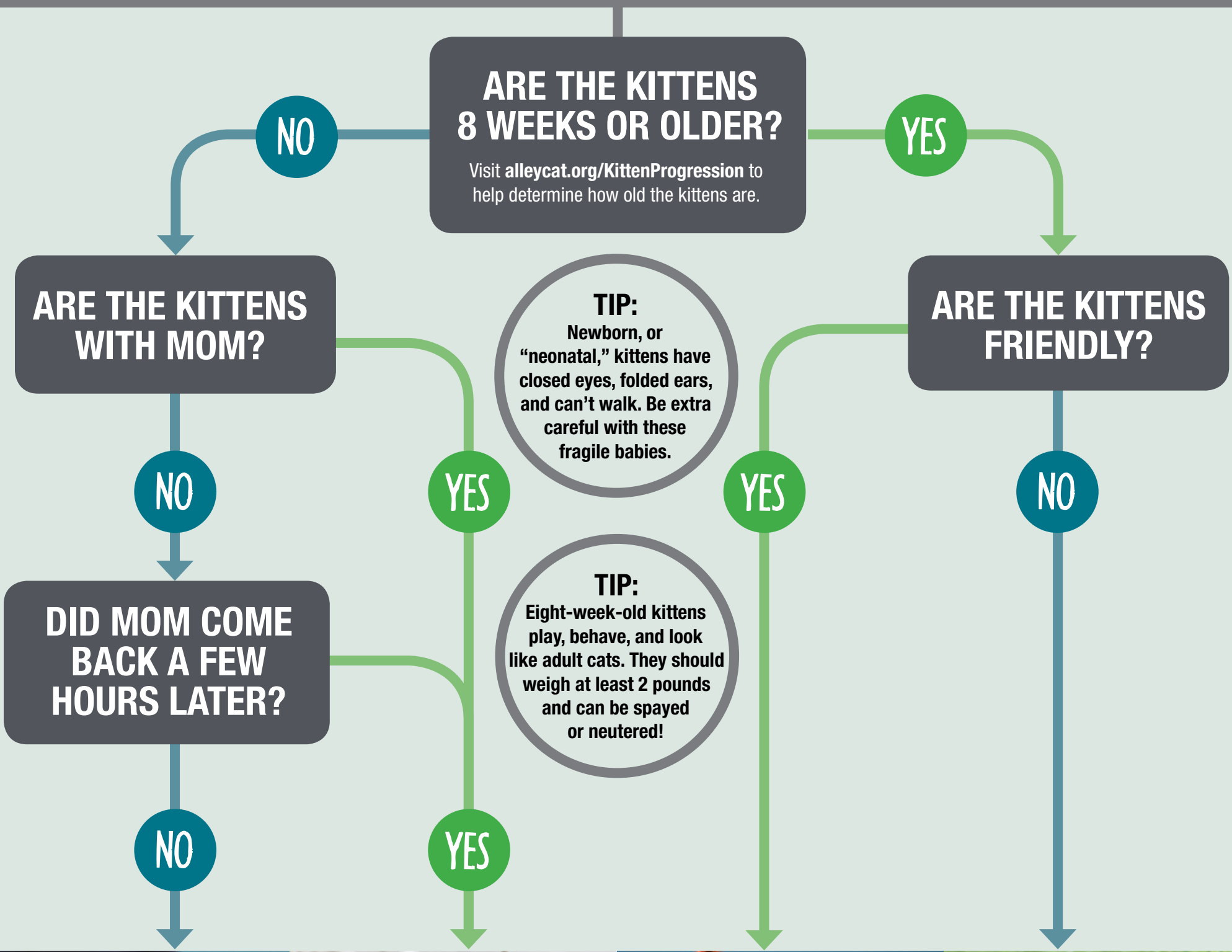


HELP, I FOUND A KITTEN!

This flowchart will help you take steps to make the best decisions for their care!

KITTEN CARE

Without mom to care for them, these kittens need your help! Neonatal kittens especially require round-the-clock care including bottle-feedings.

KEEP WITH MOM

If they are doing well, let kittens stay with mom outdoors. When they are ready for spay and neuter, TNR all of them. (Or, foster then adopt kittens.)

FIND NEW HOME

Ask a veterinarian to examine and spay or neuter the kittens. Then find homes where the kittens can be socialized to people.

TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN

Kittens over 4 months old cannot be socialized, but will live long, healthy outdoor lives. Neuter and vaccinate before returning them to their colony.
